Thriving In a Chaotic World: Building Yourself In Faith

Understanding the past helps us live into the future (Jude 14-16).

“Behold, the Lord comes with ten thousands of His holy ones, to execute judgment on all and to convict all the ungodly of all their deeds of ungodliness...” (Jude 14b-15a).

“But seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be added to you” (Matthew 6:33).

Corrupt teachers distort the Good News, yet the Good News overcomes (Jude 17-19).
