Joel 3:17-21

In a Time of Trouble: God Restores Creation

Leaning into a new day (Joel 3:17-18)

“And in that day the mountains shall drip sweet wine and the hills shall flow with milk, and all the streambeds of Judah shall flow with water; and a fountain shall come for the from the house of the Lord and water the Valley of Shittim” (Joel 3:18).

“Remember not the former things...Behold, I am doing a new thing; now it springs forth...I will make a way in the wilderness and rivers in the desert” (Isaiah 43:18-19).

“On the last day of the feast, the great day, Jesus stood up and cried out, ‘If anyone thirsts, let him come to me and drink. Whoever believes in me, as the Scripture has said, ‘Out of his heart will flow rivers of living water’” (John 7:37-38).
