Oh, Magnify the Lord: Why We Always Worship the Lord

In the face of overwhelming evil, we always worship the Lord (Psalm 124:1-5).

"If it had not been the Lord who was on our side..." (Psalm 124:1a).

"What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us?...No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. For I am sure that neither death nor life, nor angels nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers, nor height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord" (Romans 8:31, 37-39).

When we are free in Jesus, we always worship the Lord (Psalm 124:6-7).
