Home For The Holidays: Believing the Unbelievable

An unbelievable story does not mean the story is untrue (vv. 26-27)

"In the sixth month the angel Gabriel was sent from God to a city of Galilee named Nazareth, to a virgin...[named] Mary" (Luke 1:26, 27).

"For no prophecy was ever produced by the will of man, but they spoke from God as they were carried along by the Holy Spirit" (2 Peter 1:21).

Sometimes the truth is unbelievably hard (vv. 28-33)

"And he came to her and said, 'Greetings, O favored one, the Lord is with you!'
But she was greatly troubled at the saying..." (Luke 1:28-29b).

Jesus said, "I have said these things to you, that in me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation. But take heart; I have overcome the world" (John 16:33).


This unbelievable story becomes your story of deliverance and example (vv. 34-38)
