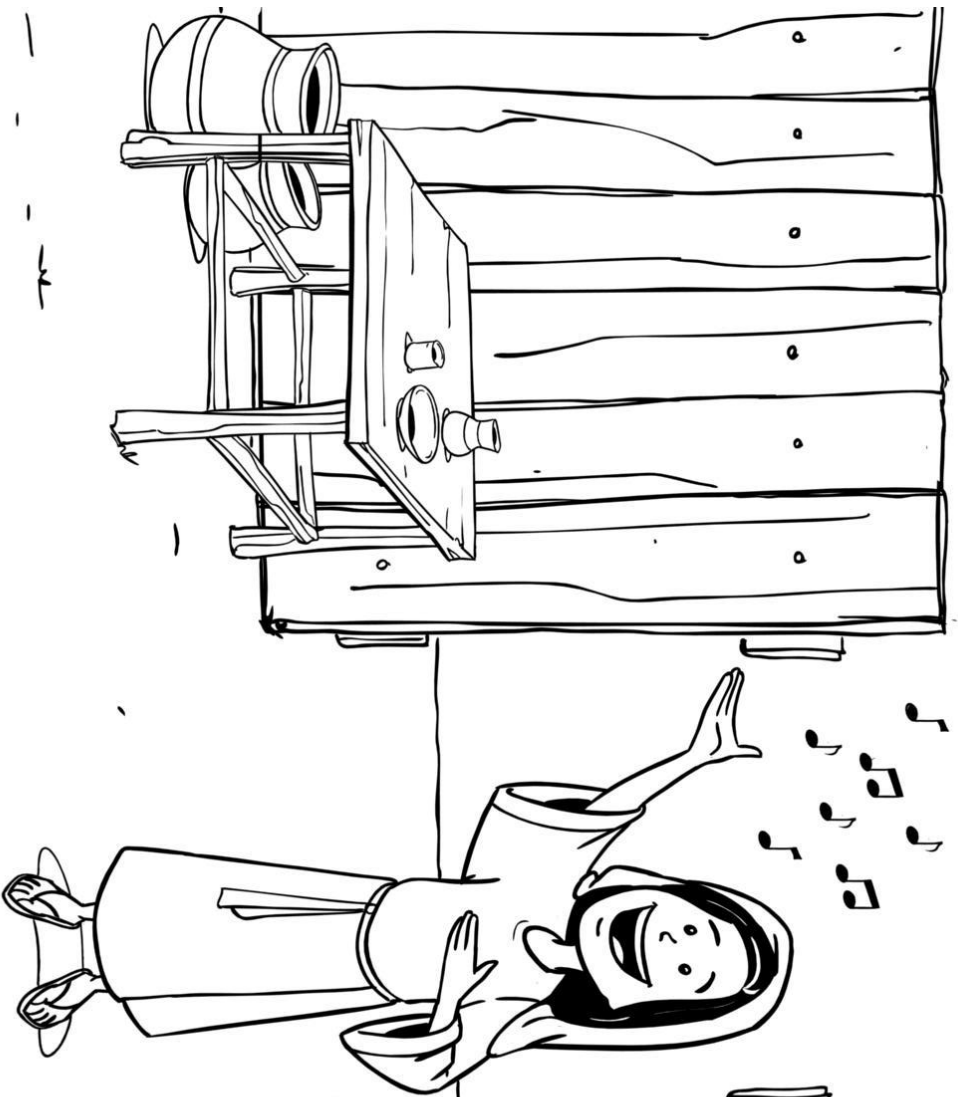
“And we know that for those who love God all things work together for good, for those who are called according to His purpose” (Romans 8:28).

(Proverbs 19:21).*

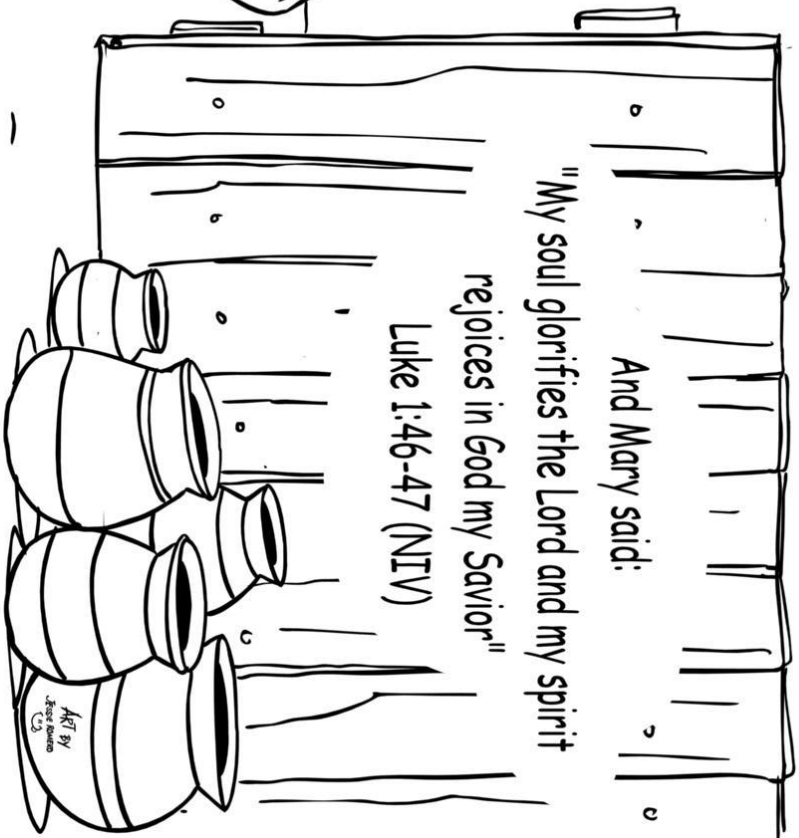
