Jesus Gives Clarity in Confusion
Mark 12:18-27

In our world of takers, Jesus gives. This Lenten Season let us be renewed in our faith by walking with Jesus, through the Gospel of Mark, from the Triumphal Entry through the Resurrection, and rediscover how in this world where everyone takes, Jesus gives us all!

***reductio ad absurdum* (Mark 12:18-23)**

“And Sadducees came to Him, who say that there is no resurrection...” (Mark 12:18).

“But avoid irreverent babble, for it will lead people into more and more ungodliness, and their talk will spread like gangrene” (2 Timothy 2:16, 17).

The Word of God *can* bring clarity or confusion (Mark 12:24-25)

“Jesus said to them, ‘Is this not the reason you are wrong, because you know neither the Scriptures nor the power of God?’” (Mark 12:24).

“I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will counsel you with my eye upon you” (Psalm 32:8).

The fullness of the Biblical witness brings clarity (Mark 12:26-27)

“And as for the dead being raised, have you not read in the book of Moses...” (Mark 12:26).

“Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one. You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might. And these words that I command you today shall be on your heart. You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise...” (Deuteronomy 6:4-7).
