The Way of the Savior: The Way of Faith

Faith in Jesus is what we all need (Mark 9:14-18).

"...someone from the crowd answered [Jesus], "Teacher, I brought my son to you, for he has a spirit that makes him mute...So I asked your disciples to cast it out, and they were not able" (Mark 9:17, 18).

"[Jesus] found disputing scribes, a distracted father, a demon-possessed boy, and defeated disciples...He silenced the scribes, He comforted the father, He healed the boy, He instructed the disciples" (quoted in *Mark 9 Study Guide* by David Guzik).

Faith in Jesus welcomes honesty (Mark 9:19-27).

"...Jesus said to him, 'If you can'! All things are possible for one who believes. Immediately the father of the child cried out and said, 'I believe; help my unbelief!'" (Mark 9:23, 24).

"For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast" (Ephesians 2:8, 9).

Faith in Jesus grows with time and effort (Mark 9:28-29).

"And when [Jesus] had entered the house, his disciples asked him privately, 'Why could we not cast it out?' And he said to them, 'This kind cannot be driven out by anything but prayer'" (Mark 9:28, 29).

"We ought always to give thanks to God for you, brothers and sisters, as is right, because your faith is growing abundantly, and the love of every one of you for one another is increasing" (1 Thessalonians 1:3).
