Fifth Sunday in Lent
Jesus Gives Life Sweetness
Mark 14:1-11

In our world of takers, Jesus gives. This Lenten Season let us be renewed in our faith by walking with Jesus, through the Gospel of Mark, from the Triumphal Entry through the Resurrection, and rediscover how in this world where everyone takes, Jesus gives us all!

Our harsh and destructive world (Mark 14:1-2)

*“And the chief priests and the scribes were seeking how to arrest Him by stealth and kill Him”
(Mark 14:1b).*

“The next day [John the Baptist] saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, ‘Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!’” (John 1:26).

Jesus Brings Forth Beauty and Sweetness (Mark 14:3-9)

“But Jesus said, ‘Leave her alone. Why do you trouble her? She has done a beautiful thing to me’” (Mark 14:6).

*“For there will never cease to be poor in the land. Therefore I command you, ‘You shall open wide your hand to your brother and sister, to the needy and to the poor, in your land’”
(Deuteronomy 15:11).*
