The Way of the Savior: The Way of Self-Denial

The centrality of discipleship

“If anyone comes after me and does not hate his own father and mother and wife and children and brothers and sisters, yes, and even his own life, he cannot be my disciple” (Luke 14:26).

“But whatever gain I had, I counted as loss for the sake of Christ. Indeed, I count everything as loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord. For his sake I have suffered the loss of all things and count them as rubbish, in order that I may gain Christ” (Philippians 3:7, 8).

The power of the cross

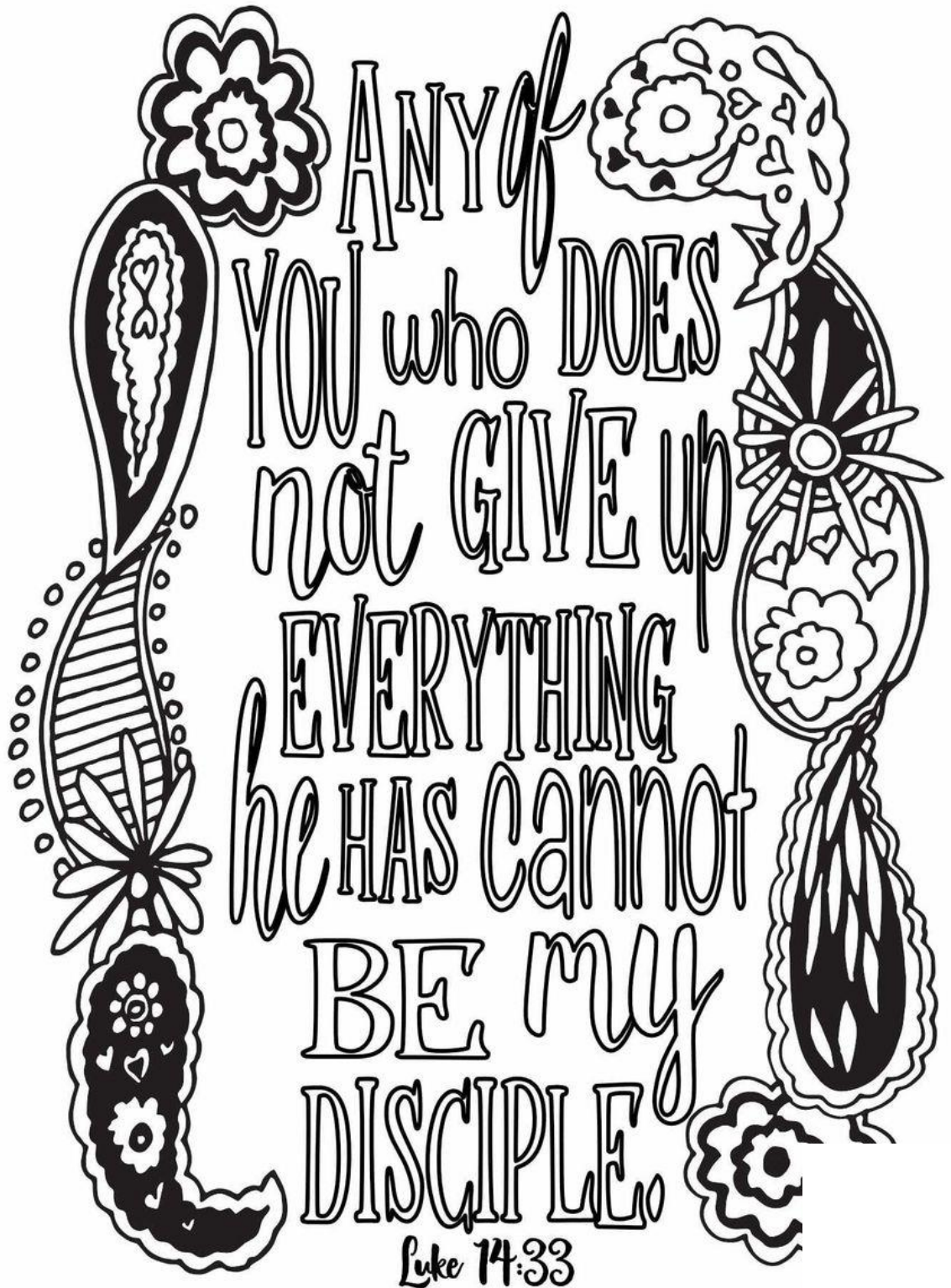
“Whoever does not bear his own cross and come after me cannot be my disciple” (Luke 14:27).

“Then Jesus told his disciples, ‘If anyone would come after me, let them deny themselves and take up their cross and follow me. For whoever would save their life will lose it, but whoever loses their life for my sake will find it’” (Matthew 16:24, 25).

The deceptiveness of the self
