March 24, 2024 Palm Sunday Jesus Gives by Taking What No One Wants Mark 11:1-11; Mark 15:33-41

In our world of takers, Jesus gives. This Lenten Season let us be renewed in our faith by walking with Jesus, through the Gospel of Mark, from the Triumphal Entry through the Resurrection, and rediscover how in this world where everyone takes, Jesus gives us all!

The Triumphal Entry: Who He Was and Is (Mark 11:1-11)

"And those who went before and those who followed were shouting, 'Hosanna! Blessed is he who come in the name of the Lord! Blessed is the coming kingdom of our father David! Hosanna in the highest!" (Mark 11:9, 10).

"Behold, your king is coming to you; righteous and having salvation is he, humble and mounted on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a donkey" (Zechariah 9:9b).

"And he said, 'Thus and so he spoke to me, saying, 'Thus says the Lord, I anoint you king over Israel." Then in hast every man of them took his garment and put it under him on the bare steps, and they blew the trumpet and proclaimed, 'Jehu is king'" (2 Kings 9:12b, 13).

The Death of Jesus: Who He Was and Is (Mark 15:33-41).

"And at the ninth hour Jesus cried with a loud voice...and breathed His last. And the curtain of the temple was torn in two, from top to bottom...the centurion said, 'Truly this man was the Son of God!"" (Mark 15:33-41 selected verses).

"And Jesus uttered a loud cry and breathed His last. And the curtain of the temple was torn in two, from top to bottom. And when the centurion who stood Facing Him, saw that in this way He breathed His last, he said, 'Truly this man was the Son of God!'" (Mark 15:37-39).

"My God, my God, why have You forsaken me? Why are You so far from saving me..." (Psalm 22:1).

"...but your iniquities have made a separation between you and your God, and your sins have hidden His face from you so that He does not hear" (Isaiah 59:2).
