Becoming Jesus People: Beyond Going Through the Motions

Where you are matters to Jesus (Revelation 2:1).

*“To the angel of the church in Ephesus write: ‘The words of him who holds the seven stars in his right hand, who walks among the seven golden lampstands’
(Revelation 2:1).*

"Ephesus was a stronghold of Satan. Here many evil things both superstitious and satanic were practiced" (Frank E. Gaebelin, *Acts*)

Going through the motions robs even the good of meaning and strength (Revelation 2:2-4).

“I know your works, your toil and your patient endurance...But I have this against you, that you have abandoned the love you had at first” (Revelation 2:2,4).
