Luke 22:39-48; 54-58; 63-65
The Way of the Savior: The Way of Suffering

Why Jesus was/is King (Luke 22:39-48).

Jesus prayed saying, saying, “Father, if you are willing, remove this cup from me. Nevertheless, not my will, but yours, be done” (Luke 22:42).

“Thus the LORD, the God of Israel, said to me: ‘Take from my hand this cup of the wine of wrath, and make all the nations to whom I send you drink it. They shall drink and stagger and be crazed because of the sword that I am sending among them’” (Jeremiah 25:15-16).

Following Jesus was and never will be easy (Luke 22:54-58).

“Peter said, ‘Man, I do not know what you are talking about.’ And immediately, while he was still speaking, the rooster crowed” (Luke 22:60).

Remembering who saved you (Luke 22:63-65).

“Now the men who were holding Jesus in custody were mocking him as they beat him. They also blindfolded him and kept asking him, ‘Prophesy! Who is it that struck you?’” (Luke 22:63-64).

“He has borne our griefs and carried out sorrows; yet we esteemed him stricken, smitten by God, afflicted. But he was pierced for our transgressions; he was crushed for our iniquities” (Isaiah 53:4-5a).
