Revelation 2:12-17

Becoming Jesus People: The Importance of the Entire Biblical Witness

The importance of the full testimony of scripture (Revelation 2:12).

“And to the angel of the church in Pergamum write: ‘The words of him who has the sharp two-edged sword’” (Revelation 2:12).

“For the word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing to the division of soul and of spirit, of joints and of marrow, and discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart” (Hebrews 4:12).

First, the Good News, God goes before you (Revelation 2:13).

“I know where you dwell, where Satan's throne is. Yet you hold fast my name...” (Revelation 2:13).

“It is the LORD who goes before you. He will be with you; he will not leave you or forsake you. Do not fear or be dismayed” (Deuteronomy 31:8).

Second, the not so good news, it is so easy to get off track (Revelation 2:14-16).

“But I have a few things against you: you have some there who hold the teaching of Balaam...therefore repent...” (Revelation 2:14, 16).

“From that time Jesus began to preach, saying, ‘Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand’” (Matthew 4:17).

Third, living for Jesus means newness of life now and forever (Revelation 2:17).

“He who has an ear, let him hear...To the one who conquers I will give some of the hidden manna, and I will give him a white stone, with a new name written on the stone that no one knows except the one who receives it” (Revelation 2:17).

“This is the bread that came down from heaven, not like the bread the fathers ate, and died. Whoever feeds on this bread will live forever” (John 6:58).
