What is the Second Harvest?

"You shall count seven full weeks from the day after the Sabbath, from the day that you brought the sheaf of the wave offering [omer]. You shall count fifty days to the day after the seventh Sabbath. Then you shall present a grain offering of new grain to the LORD (Leviticus 23:15-16).

"But each in his own order: Christ the first fruits, then at his coming those who belong to Christ" (1 Corinthians 15:23).

"Let both grow together until the harvest, and at harvest time I will tell the reapers, 'Gather the weeds first and bind them in bundles to be burned, but gather the wheat into my barn'" (Matthew 13:30).

"You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden" (Matthew 5:14).

"The people who walked in darkness have seen a great light; those who dwelt in a land of deep darkness, on them light has shone" (Isaiah 9:1-3).

"Put in the sickle, for the harvest is ripe. Go in, tread, for the winepress is full. The vats overflow, for their evil is great" (Joel 3:13).

"So he who sat on the cloud swung his sickle across the earth, and the earth was reaped" (Revelation 14:16).
