Jesus Walking on Water: More Than a Great Story

Prayer is Essential to Life! (45-46)

"Immediately he made his disciples get into the boat and go before him to the other side, to Bethsaida, while he dismissed the crowd" Mark 6:45).

"And rising very early in the morning, while it was still dark, he departed and went out to a desolate place, and there he prayed" (Mark 1:35).

The Joy of Storms for the Faithful (47-52)

"And [Jesus] saw that they were making headway painfully, for the wind was against them. And about the fourth watch of the night he came to them, walking on the sea. He meant to pass by them..." (Mark 6:48).

"The apostolic crew rowed, and rowed, and rowed, and it was no fault of theirs that they made no progress, 'for the wind was contrary unto them.' The Christian man may make little or no headway, and yet it may be no fault of his, for the wind is contrary. Our good Lord will take the will for the deed, and reckon our progress, not by our apparent advance, but by the hearty intent with which we tug at the oars" (Charles Spurgeon).
