Lot's Wife and What Went Wrong

"Lot's wife, behind him, looked back, and she became a pillar of salt"
(Genesis 19:26).

Always follow the Lord: Let Go of the Life You Wanted

"Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect" (Romans 12:2).

Remember to Cling to the Lord and Flee the Bondage of Sin
