Exodus 12:33-42; Exodus 14 (various verses)

The Gifts of Wandering and Wonder:

Exodus from Egypt and Crossing the Red Sea

The Lord set Israel free. Being free is hard.

“When Pharaoh drew near, the people of Israel lifted up their eyes, and behold, the Egyptians were marching after them, and they feared greatly. And the people of Israel cried out to the LORD. They said to Moses, ‘Is it because there are no graves in Egypt that you have taken us away to die in the wilderness?’” (Exodus 14:10-11).

“...if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed” (John 8:36).

In the chaos, God guides to order.

“The Lord said to Moses, ‘Why do you cry to me? Tell the people of Israel to go forward. Lift up your staff, and stretch out your hand over the sea and divide it, that the people of Israel may go through the sea on dry ground’” (Exodus 14:15, 16).
