Jesus Cares for Hurting People (vv. 10-13)

“Now [Jesus] was teaching in one of the synagogues on the Sabbath. And behold, there was a woman who had had a disabling spirit...And he laid his hands on her, and immediately she was made straight, and she glorified God”
(Luke 13:10, 11, 13).

“...those eighteen on whom the tower in Siloam fell and killed them: do you think that they were worse offenders than all the others who live in Jerusalem? No, I tell you; but unless you repent, you will all likewise perish” (Luke 13:3-5).

The Church Must Care for Hurting People (vv. 14-17)

“But the ruler of the synagogue, indignant because Jesus had healed on the Sabbath..[Jesus] answered him, ‘You hypocrites!...ought not this woman...be loosed from this bond on the Sabbath day?’” (Luke 13:14-16).
