Revisiting the Bible: More Than Children's Stories

Daniel 6 (selected verses)

The Dual Calling of Daniel and the Lion's Den

We are called to live in a corrupt world (Daniel 6:1-9)

“And the king planned to set him over the whole kingdom. Then the high officials and the satraps sought to find a ground for complaint against Daniel” (Daniel 6:3-4).

“If the world hates you, know that it has hated me before it hated you” (John 15:18).

“Be subject for the Lord's sake to every human institution, whether it be to the emperor as supreme, or to governors as sent by him to punish those who do evil and to praise those who do good. For this is the will of God, that by doing good you should put to silence the ignorance of foolish people” (1 Peter 2:13-15).

We are called to follow God in all things (10-28)

“When Daniel knew that the document had been signed, he went to his house where he had windows in his upper chamber open toward Jerusalem. He got down on his knees three times a day and prayed and gave thanks before his God, as he had done previously” (Daniel 6:10).

“...who through faith conquered kingdoms, enforced justice, obtained promises, stopped the mouths of lions...” (Hebrews 11:33).

“For this is the will of God, that by doing good you should put to silence the ignorance of foolish people” (1 Peter 2:15).
