Creating a World in Which to Flourish: Making a Clean Sweep

Sometimes we just have to make a clean sweep of things (1:1-6)

"I will utterly sweep away everything from the face of the earth," declares the Lord" (1:2).

"Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come" (2 Corinthians 5:17).

Starting over can be painful and cathartic (1:7-13)

"Be silent before the Lord God! For the day of the Lord is near..." (1:7a).

"The people regarded all religions as equally true. The philosophers regarded all religions as equally false. The politicians regarded all religions as equally useful" (Edward Gibbon, *The Decline and Fall of the Roman Empire*).

When the truth is faced, hope is on the horizon (1:14-2:3)
