August 6, 2023 **Back to School With God** Revisiting the Bible: More Than Children's Stories Joshua 6:1-7; 15-17; 23-27 When the Walls Came Tumbling Down: Joshua and the Battle of Jericho

Nothing and no one are shut off from God. (Joshua 6:1-5)

"Now Jericho was shut up inside and outside because of the people of Israel. None went out, and none came in. And the LORD said to Joshua..." (Joshua 6:1, 2a).
