September 17, 2023 Joel 2:18-27 In a Time of Trouble: God Restores the Faithful

God's judgment and punishment is always restorative (2:18).

"Then the LORD became jealous [was filled with passion] for His land and had pity on His people" (Joel 2:18).

"For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many" (Mark 10:45).

God always answers our prayers (2:19-21).

"Fear not, O land; be glad and rejoice, for the LORD has done great things!" (Joel 2:21).

"Likewise the Spirit helps us in our weakness. For we do not know what to pray for as we ought, but the Spirit Himself intercedes for us with groanings too deep for words. And He who searches hearts knows what is the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for the saints according to the will of God" (Romans 8:26-27).

Our actions do not change who God is (2:22-26).

"I will restore to you the years that the swarming locust has eaten" (Joel 2:25).

"Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever" (Hebrews 13:8).

God longs to be with His children (2:27).

"You shall know that I am in the midst of Israel, and that I am the LORD your God and there is none else. And my people shall never again be put to shame" (Joel 2:27).

"So then you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God, built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus himself being the cornerstone, in whom the whole structure, being joined together, grows into a holy temple in the Lord. In him you also are being built together into a dwelling place for God by the Spirit" (Ephesians 2:19-22).
