Joel 2:28-32

In a Time of Trouble: God Pours out His Spirit

The joyous beginning of the end (Joel 2:28-29)

“And it shall come to pass afterward, that I will pour out my Spirit on all flesh...” (Joel 2:28a).

“But Peter, standing with the eleven, lifted up his voice and addressed them: ‘Men of Judea and all who dwell in Jerusalem, let this be known to you, and give ear to my words ...’” (Acts 2:14).
