The Healing King and His Invitation (Matthew 8:1-9:38)

The Kings Touch – Jesus Heals the Untouchable
(Matthew 8:1-4; 9:20-22)

“And Jesus stretched out His hand and touched him, saying, ‘I will; be clean.’ And immediately his leprosy was cleansed” (Matthew 8:3).

“Jesus turned, and seeing her He said, ‘Take heart, daughter; your faith has made you well.’ And instantly the woman was made well” (Matthew 9:22).

The King’s Word – Jesus Heals by Sovereign Authority
(Matthew 8:5-13; 8:23-27; 9:1-8)

*“For I too am a man under authority, with soldiers under me. And I say to one, ‘Go,’ and he goes, and to another, ‘Come,’ and he comes, and to my servant. ‘Do this,’ and he does it.’
When Jesus heard this, He marveled...” (Matthew 8:9-10a).*

“And He said to them, ‘Why are you afraid, O you of little faith?’ Then He rose and rebuked the winds and the sea, and there was a great calm (Matthew 8:26).

“And when Jesus saw their faith, He said to the paralytic, ‘Take heart, my son; your sins are forgiven’” (Matthew 9:2b).

The King’s Call – Jesus Invites the Unworthy to Follow
(Matthew 9:9-13; 9:18-26; 9:35-38)

“As Jesus passed on from there, He saw a man called Matthew sitting at the tax booth, and He said to him, ‘Follow me.’ And he rose and followed Him” (Matthew 9:9).

“When He saw the crowds, He had compassion for them, because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd” (Matthew 9:36).
