**Thank you for your interest in the 2018 Trinity Grace Middle and High School Mission Trip.**

**This event is available for** those who have just completed their 6<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade year of school.

**Dates:** the Mission Trip is June 3-9, 2018.

**Cost:** \$125 which includes a \$75 non-refundable, transferable deposit required for registration. Participants are expected to bring additional funds for an “or the road” meal June 3 and 9, a beach meal (\$12-30 depending on your child’s palate), and miscellaneous spending money.

**Registration:** \$75 and Permission/Medical Form due NO LATER than 20<sup>th</sup> at the parent/youth Mission Trip Q&A, 5:30 pm, Trinity Grace Church

**Space Is Limited:** only a total of 13 students may attend. Registration is “first come, first served.” A youth is registered for the mission trip when a completed “Parental Permission and Medical Authorization Form” and the \$75 deposit are turned in to Tully Hunter (770-865-4378). **Space Limited:** 13 students (those having COMPLETED grades 6-12)

**Finances:** If there is a financial concern, please do not let money concerns result in an automatic no! Contact Tully Hunter to discuss financing options.

**A few things to note:** we staying in a private home with girls downstairs and boys upstairs. Breakfast and some other meals will be prepared by the group. Due to the variety of outreach environments bedtimes and morning times will vary greatly on a daily basis and youth must observe lights out and wake-up times.

**Cellphone and electronic device policy:** at night, during times we are working, and during group meetings, cellphones will **NOT** be permitted. At these times all electronic devices will be collected and stored. Youth will be encouraged to contact their adults daily. In case of an emergency call 770-865-4378, any time, 24/7.
