Table and the Covenant (Matthew 26:1-29)

The Plot and the Passover (Matthew 26:1-5; 17-19)

“You know that after two days the Passover is coming, and the Son of Man will be delivered up to be crucified” (Matthew 26:2).

The Weight of Extravagant Love (Matthew 26:6-16)

“For she has done a beautiful thing to me...In pouring this ointment on my body, she has done it to prepare me for my burial. Truly, I say to you, wherever this gospel is proclaimed in the whole world, what she has done will also be told in memory of her” (Matthew 26:10, 12-13).

Broken People at a Broken Table (Matthew 26:20-25)
