Now What? Spirit Powered Gospel
Acts 2-3

The Spirit Poured Out (Acts 2:1-21, 32-33)

*“Being therefore exalted at the right hand of God, and having received from the Father the promise of the Holy Spirit, He has poured out this that you yourselves are seeing and hearing”
(Acts 2:33).*

The Exalted Christ (Acts 2:22-31, 36, 3:13-15)

“Let all the house of Israel therefore know for certain that God has made Him both Lord and Christ, this Jesus whom you crucified” (Acts 2:36)
