Now What? Opposition Meets Boldness
Acts 4-5

Opposition Is Normal When Christ is Preached (Acts 4:1-4, 5:17-29)

“And as they were speaking to the people, the priests and the captain of the temple and the Sadducees came upon them, greatly annoyed because they were teaching the people and proclaiming in Jesus the resurrection from the dead” (Acts 4:1-2).

“But the high priest rose up...filled with jealousy they arrested the apostles...” (Acts 5:17-18).

Boldness Is Grounded in Jesus’ Identity (Acts 4:5-22, 5:30-32)

“This Jesus is the stone that was rejected by you, the builders, which has become the cornerstone. And there is salvation in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved” (Acts 4:11-12).

“The God of our fathers raised Jesus...God exalted Him at His right hand... to give repentance to Israel and forgiveness of sins” (Acts 5:30-31).

The Church Prays for Boldness, not Comfort (Acts 4:23-31; 5:33-42)

“When they were released, they went to their friends and reported what the chief priests and the elders had said to them” (Acts 4:23).

“When they heard this, they were enraged and wanted to kill them” (Acts 5:33).

Boldness Must Be Matched by Holiness and Truth (Acts 4:32-5:16)

“Now the full number of those who believed were of one heart and soul, and no one said that any of the things that belonged to him was his own, but they had everything in common” (Acts 4:32).

“But a man named Ananias, with his wife Sapphira, sold a piece of property, and with his wife's knowledge he kept back for himself...” (Acts 5:1-2).
