Now What? The Church Welcomes
Acts 11-12

1. No Barriers to Grace (Acts 11:1-18)

“If then God gave the same gift to them as He gave to us when we believed in the Lord Jesus Christ, who was I that I could stand in God's way?’ When they heard these things they fell silent. And they glorified God, saying, ‘Then to the Gentiles also God has granted repentance that leads to life’” (Acts 11:17-18).

2. Grace to the Church (Acts 11:19-30)

“And the hand of the Lord was with them, and a great number who believed turned to the Lord...So the disciples determined, every one according to his ability, to send relief to the brothers and sisters living in Judea.
