Acts 13-14

Launched By the Spirit (Acts 13:1-4)

“While they were worshiping the Lord and fasting, the Holy Spirit said, ‘Set apart for me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them.’ Then after fasting and praying they laid their hands on them and sent them off” (Acts 13:2-3).

Sent by the Spirit to Speak and Confirm (Acts 13:5-52; 14:1-18)
