Now What? Scattering for Witness
Acts 6-8

In Suffering, Christ Reigns (Acts 6-7)

“And Stephen, full of grace and power, was doing great wonders and signs among the people...But they could not withstand the wisdom and the Spirit with which he was speaking...Now when they heard these things they were enraged...Then they cast him out of the city and stoned him. And the witnesses laid down their garments at the feet of a young man named Saul” (Acts 6:8, 10; 7:54, 58).

Scattering Becomes Sending (Acts 8:1-8)

“Now those who were scattered went about preaching the word” (Acts 8:4).

The Gospel Crosses Every Boundary (Acts 8:9-40)

“But there was a man named Simon, who had previously practiced magic in the city...Then Philip opened his mouth, and beginning with this Scripture he told him the good news about Jesus...Philip found himself at Azotus, and as he passed through he preached the gospel to all the towns until he came to Caesarea” (Acts 8:9, 35, 40).
