Leviticus 19:33-34; Isaiah 58:7; Matthew 25;

Hospitality: Not An Option (Romans 12:13)

“Contribute to the needs of the saints and seek to show hospitality” (Romans 12:13).

Rooted in God’s Grace and Mercy (Leviticus 19:33-34)

*“When a stranger sojourns with you in your land, you shall not do them wrong. You shall treat the stranger who sojourns with you as the native among you, and you shall love them as yourself, for you were strangers in the land of Egypt: I am the LORD your God”
(Leviticus 19:33-34).*

Extending Beyond Us (Hebrews 13:2)

“Do not neglect to show hospitality to strangers, for thereby some have entertained angels unawares” (Hebrew 13:2).

Practical Mercy (Isaiah 58:7)
