A Word For A Restless Age: Two Evils
Jeremiah 2:1-13

Covenant Forgetfulness Exposed (Jeremiah 2:1-8)

Evil #1: Forsaking the God Who Acted

“Thus says the LORD: ‘What wrong did your fathers find in me that they went far from me, and went after worthlessness, and became worthless?’” (Jeremiah 2:5).

“You hypocrites! Well did Isaiah prophesy of you, when he said: ‘This people honors me with their lips, but their heart is far from me; in vain do they worship me, teaching as doctrines the commandments of men’” (Matthew 15:7-9).

Empty Substitutes and Spiritual Dryness (Jeremiah 2:9-13)

Evil #2: Exchanging Glory for What Cannot Profit

*“Be appalled, O heavens, at this; be shocked, be utterly desolate, declares the LORD...”
(Jeremiah 2:12).*

"For what does it profit a man to gain the whole world and forfeit his soul?" (Mark 8:36).
