A Word For A Restless Age: Called to Speak
Jeremiah 1:4-19

Appointed (Jeremiah 1:4-5)

“Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, and before you were born I consecrated you; I appointed you a prophet to the nations” (Jeremiah 1:5).

“You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit and that your fruit should abide, so that whatever you ask the Father in my name, He may give it to you” (John 15:16).

Afraid (Jeremiah 1:6-8)

“Then I said, Ah, Lord GOD! Behold, I do not know how to speak, for I am only a youth” (Jeremiah 1:7).
